4. Suffolk launches £150,000 Match Funder scheme for community action on the climate emergency – Green Suffolk

The fund will support community groups with up to 50% of the cost of their climate change project, to a maximum of £10,000.

The Suffolk Climate Action Community Match Funder has been set up by the Suffolk

Climate Change Partnership (SCCP), which includes West Suffolk Council, to

contribute towards the vision of a carbon neutral Suffolk by 2030.

It welcomes applications on a range of projects or events from installing solar panels and insulation, to promoting walking and cycling.

7. The Sunnica Solar Energy Farm "Statuary Consultation Period" was completed on the 18th of December 2020.

Sunnica's Adequacy of Consultation has now been accepted by the planning inspectors.

The SCC/WSC & CCC/ECDC have now submitted their respective Relevant Representation reports 17th March 2022. The Examination process has restarted on the 28th September https://infrastructure.planninginspectorate.gov.uk/projects/eastern/sunnica-energyfarm/?ipcsection=overview

The joint 4 Council "Local Impact Report" has now been submitted (October 2022) and once the Examiners have accepted this it will be published.

Currently West Suffolk Council are working through their "Written Representation" response, again once this has been submitted and accepted by the Examiners this will be published accordingly. (November 2022)
